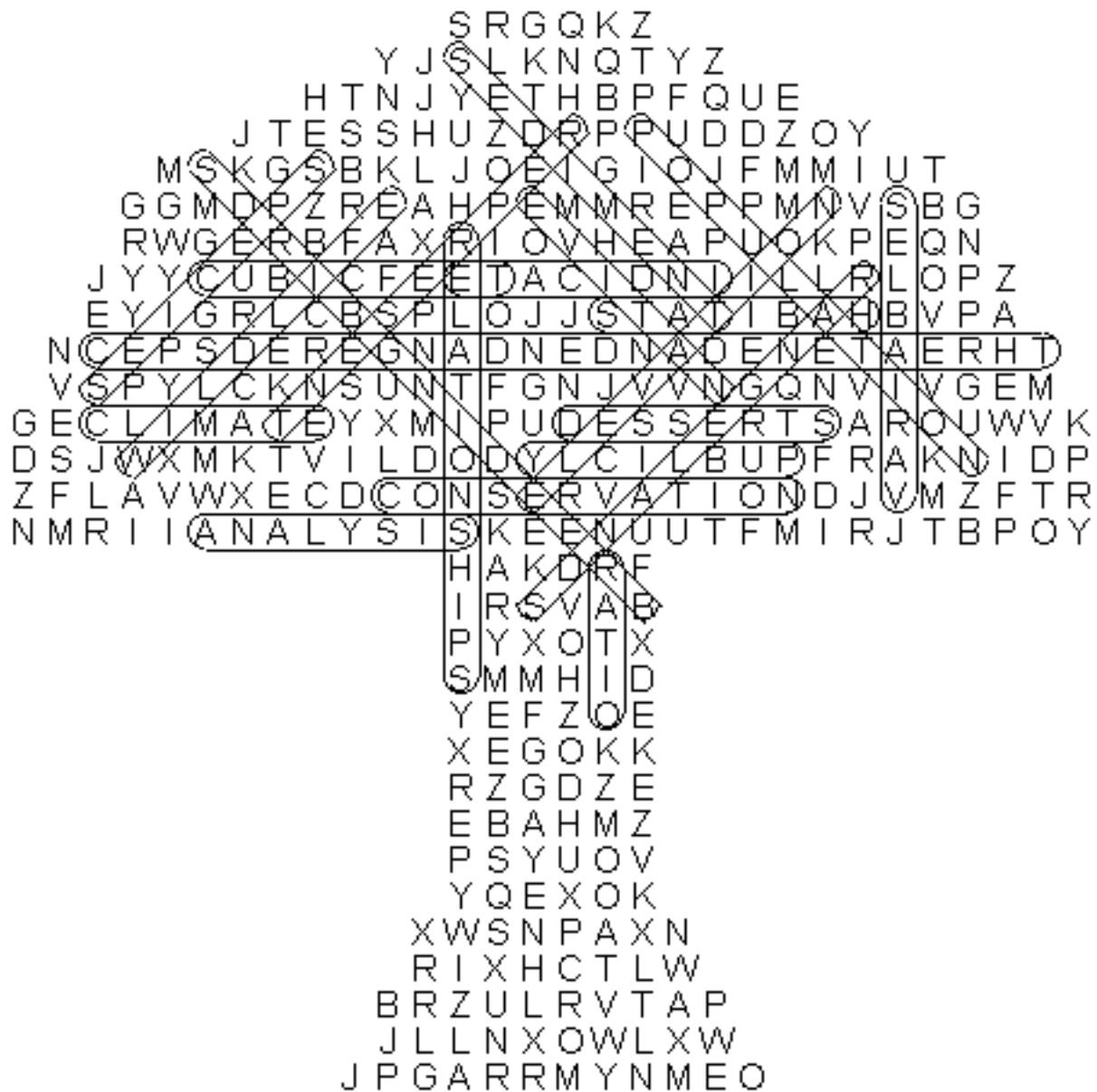


## Stress Test



- (analyze) Separating something into its parts to examine it.
- (breeding birds) Birds who are also breeding and raising their young in the area they are living.
- (climate) Average weather conditions of a place over a number of years.
- (conservation) The care and protection of natural resources such as forests and water.
- (cubic feet) The summed volume of many cubes that are each 1 foot long, 1 foot high, and 1 foot wide.
- (elevation) The height above sea level.
- (habitat) Environments where a plant or animal naturally grow and live.
- (indicate) To point out or point to.
- (inhabits) Naturally occurring in an area.
- (population) The total number of individuals of separate types of plants or animals occupying an area.
- (publicly) By the government, or behalf of all citizens.
- (rangelands) Open lands which are mostly covered with grasses or shrubs.
- (ratio) The relation of one thing to another in size, amount, etc. Proportion.
- (relationships) Connections in some fashion of two or more things.
- (represent) To be an example of.
- (sediment) Matter set down by wind or water, such as sand or soil.
- (species) Groups of organisms that resemble one another in appearance, behavior, chemical processes, and genetic structure.
- (stressed) Strained, pressured, or placed under tension.
- (threatened and endangered spec) Species whose numbers are so low as to threaten or endanger its existence in the future.
- (variables) Things that can vary in number or amount.
- (wildlife) Animals that live in the wild.
