

Attack of the Killer Anthracnose



1. (anthracnose) Plant disease identified by dark spots and blisters; caused by imperfect fungi.
2. (control) Organism or object used for comparison in an experiment.
3. (dogwood) A type of deciduous tree with flowers.
4. (fungicide) An agent that destroys fungi or prevents its growth.
5. (fungus) A plant-like organism that contains no chlorophyll and reproduces by spores; for example, mold, mushrooms, mildew.
6. (landscape) The visual land, such as trees, water, and sky.

7. (photoautotrophs) Formation of carbohydrates when chlorophyll is exposed to light; refers to the ability of plants to make their own food with the use of sunlight.
