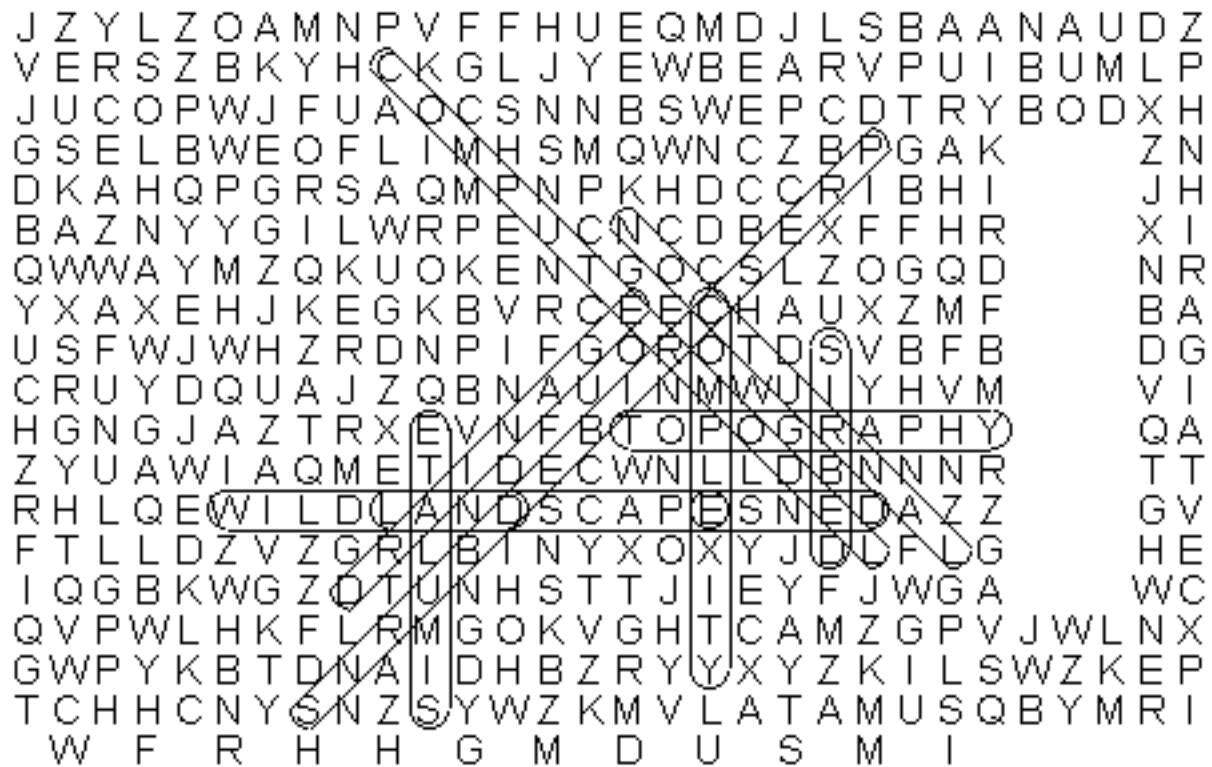


On Top of Old Smokey
