6. (nurseries) Area where plants and trees are grown from seed.
7. (ozone layer) Upper layer of atmosphere which protects earth's surface from harmful solar radiation.
8. (questionnaire) Printed or written form of questions used to gather information.
9. (seedlings) Small, young trees.
