
## Fighting Fire with Fire



- (adapt) To change so as to fit new conditions.
- (climate) The average condition of the weather at a place.
- (consenus)
   Agreement of all or most.
- (conserve) To avoid wasteful or destructive use of something.
- (ecologist) A person who studies the relationship between living things and their environment.
- (extinction) No longer existing.

- (habitat) Environment where a plant or animal naturally grows and lives.
- (land management)
   Decisions and actions involving natural lands to achieve specific purposes.
- (mammals)
   Warm-blooded
   animals that have a
   backbone; Female
   mammals have glands
   to produce milk for
   feeding their young.
- (nonnative) Not naturally occurring in an area.

- (randomly) Away of selecting a smaller number from a group in such a way that all members of the group have the same chance of being selected.
- 12. (scrub) An area with short, stubby trees or bushes.
- (species) Groups of organisms that resemble one another in appearance, behavior, chemical processes, and genetic structure.
- 14. (threatened) Legal term meaning the existence of the species is likely to become endangered in the future.
- (wildfire) An uncontrolled wild land fire started naturally or by careless human action.
