
Do What You Water



- (assumptions)
 Things that are taken for granted.
- (average) The number gotten by dividing the sum of two or more quantities by the number of quantities added.
- (categories)
 Divisions of a main subject or group.
- (census) An official count of all the people in a country, including other information such as their sex, age, and occupation.
- (data) Facts or figures studied in order to make a conclusion
- (downstream) In the direction in which a stream is flowing.
- (groundwater)
 Water that sinks
 into the soil and is
 stored in aquifers.

- (irrigation) The act of watering by means of canals, ditches, pipes, or sprinklers.
- (natural resources)
 Things in nature that take care of a human need, such as oil.
- 10. (reservoirs) Places where something, especially water, is collected and stored for use.
- 11. (surface water)
 Water that does not seep into the ground or evaporate into the atmosphere.
